The module is designed to build on the skills in LA-1403 through developing greater fluency and accuracy in using <i>el-Hurf El-Hijāiyyah</i> .			
<b>Module Content :</b>			
This module will build on the skills through special topics which include: Sports, Hobbies, Family, Home, Functions and celebrations in Brunei Darussalam and travel. All the four skills will have deeper and more detailed focus:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading -understanding more demanding Arabic text on specially chosen topics.</li> <li>• Listening - Intensive listening of longer text and developing vocabulary in context.</li> <li>• Grammar- practicing tense forms and verb patterns (Past, Present and Future Tense).</li> <li>• Writing – creating continuous texts through a series of related sentences.</li> </ul>			
Classroom methodology is a combination of paired work, small group interaction and whole class activities. A range of technology including video, audio and ICT is used to support and enhance learning in a nurturing and non-threatening environment.
