<b>Aims/Objectives/Rationale:</b>				
<p>This module is designed to further develop the Filipino language skills of students who have completed LP-1403 and LP-2403. Filipino will be the primary medium of instruction although English explanations may still be given for advanced expressions and concepts. The module will focus on spoken and reading skills although all four skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking will be integrated in the module.</p>				
<b>Module Content:</b>				
<p>In this module, students will engage in complex conversations in Filipino on a range of specialised topics in personal/informal and professional/formal contexts. They will be encouraged to initiate and maintain longer conversations of great depth and intensity.</p> <p>Students will also be taught to read various types of Filipino texts involving more complex sentences. In addition, students will also be taught write different genres of texts in Filipino. The teaching of Filipino grammatical and lexical items and relevant areas of Filipino culture and customs will be integrated into the teaching of the above skills.</p>
