The module will focus on advanced Filipino language skills and functions which are useful in the social, academic and professional environment and students will be taught to use these skills and functions to communicate in social, academic and professional situations.</p>			
Module Content:			
<p>In this module, students will be trained to express themselves logically, accurately and fluently, and they will be helped to develop the necessary skills to do the following in Filipino:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - make presentations - write administrative letters - write long essays - participate in, or chair, meetings - engage in technical discussions. <p>The teaching methodology will combine whole class seminars and group work, and will use various information technology tools.</p>
