Aims/Objectives/Rationale:			
<p>This module is designed to build on the language skills of students who have completed LB-1404 and is intended to increase students' oral fluency and writing ability.</p> <p>This module will focus on the written and spoken skills although all four skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking will be integrated in this module. Malay will be the primary medium of instruction.</p>			
Module Content:			
<p>LB-2403 covers four main strands:</p> <p>(a) Providing more grammatical practice to increase accuracy.</p> <p>(b) Developing oral fluency through the construction and use of compound sentences and the creative combination of sentences in longer stretches of discourse.</p> <p>(c) Active listening to longer dialogues and contextualised conversations for specific purposes.</p> <p>(d) Providing more writing practice to increase accuracy and fluency through the use of new combinations of vocabulary items.</p>
