Aims/Objectives/Rationale:			
<p>This module is designed to further develop the Malay language skills of students who have completed LB-2403. Malay will be the primary means of instruction in this module.</p> <p>Students will be given practice to enable them to engage in complex conversations in Malay in greater depth and intensity, and to compose and write different genres of texts.</p>			
Module Content:			
<p>In this course students will engage in a range of more specialised topics in personal/informal, and professional/formal contexts. They will be encouraged to initiate, maintain and lead longer conversations.</p> <p>Students will also be taught to read texts in Malay involving more advanced sentence constructions and word-combinations.</p> <p>The teaching of Malay grammatical and lexical items and areas of Malay culture and customs which are directly relevant to the language will be integrated into the teaching of the above skills.</p>
