<b>Aims/Objectives/Rationale:</b>			
<p>The module is designed to further develop the Mandarin language skills of students who have completed LM-2404. Mandarin will be the primary means of instruction although English explanations may still be given for advanced expressions and concepts if required.</p> <p>Students will be given practice to perform most language functions needed for areas related to communication in academic and professional situations.</p>			
<b>Module Content:</b>			
<p>In this module students will engage in communication on a range of specialized topics whereby they will be encouraged to initiate, maintain and lead longer conversations.</p> <p>Students will be taught to :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- use language appropriately depending on the social context.</li> <li>- understand, express and comment orally and in writing on abstract concepts such as opinions, emotions and impressions.</li> <li>- discuss various issues pertaining to cultural and social subjects.</li> </ul> <p>Classroom methodology is a combination of group work and whole class lecturing and will include extensive use of technology and media to support and enhance learning.</p>
