<b>Aims/Objectives/Rationale:</b>			
<p>The course is designed to further develop the Spanish language skills of students who have completed LS-1403 and LS-2403. Spanish will be the primary means of instruction although English explanations may still be given for advanced expressions and concepts.</p> <p>Students will be given practice to enable them to engage in complex conversations in Spanish in greater depth and intensity and compose different genres of texts.</p>			
<b>Module Content:</b>			
<p>In this course students will engage in a range of more specialised topics in personal/informal, and professional/formal contexts. They will be encouraged to initiate, maintain and lead longer conversations. Students will also be taught to read various genres of texts in Spanish script involving more advanced combinations. Besides that, these students will write scripts in Spanish and reproduce the combinatory sentences.</p> <p>The teaching of Spanish grammatical and lexical items and relevant areas of Spanish culture and customs will be integrated into the teaching of the above skills.</p>
