Aims/Objectives/Rationale:			
<p>The course is designed to further develop the Spanish language skills of students who have completed LS-2404. Spanish will be the primary means of instruction although English explanations may still be given for advanced expressions and concepts.</p> <p>Students will be given practice to perform most language functions needed for areas related to communication in academic and professional situations.</p>			
Module Content:			
<p>In this course students will engage in communication on a range of specialized topics whereby they will be encouraged to initiate, maintain and lead longer conversations.</p> <p>Students will be taught to :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - use language appropriately depending on the social context. - understand, express and comment orally and in writing on abstract concepts such as opinions, emotions and impressions. - discuss various issues pertaining to cultural and social subjects. <p>Classroom methodology is a combination of group work and whole class lecturing and will include extensive use of technology and media to support and enhance learning.</p>
