<p>In this module, students will be trained to express themselves logically, accurately and fluently, and they will be helped to develop the necessary skills to do the following in Thai:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - make presentations - write administrative letters - write long essays - participate in, or chair, meetings - engage in technical discussions. <p>The teaching methodology will combine whole class seminars and group work, and will use various information technology tools.</p>
