Aims/Objectives/Rationale:			
<p>This module is designed to build on the Tutong language skills of students who have completed LY-1443 and is intended to increase students' oral fluency and writing ability. The module will focus on the spoken and written skills although all four skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking will be integrated in the module. Malay will be the primary medium of instruction.</p>			
Module Content:			
<p>In this module, students will further develop their oral fluency in Tutong through the construction and use of compound sentences and the creative combination of sentences in longer stretches of discourse. They will also practise active listening to longer dialogues and contextualised conversations for specific purposes.</p> <p>In addition, students will be given more writing practice to increase their accuracy and fluency through the use of new combinations of vocabulary items, as well as more grammatical practice.</p>
