<p>The module is designed to give learners the skills enabling them to effectively communicate in French by combining the grammatical structures studied and practiced in class with appropriate words and phrases in a particular context. Difficulties of pronunciation should be reduced.</p> <p>At the end of the module, students should be able to communicate correctly in a wide range of situations.</p>			
<b>Module Content :</b>			
<u>Grammar</u>			
Students will be taught important grammatical structures including (but not limited to) modal verbs, verbs not ending in <i>er</i> , relative clauses or demonstrative pronouns.			
<u>Vocabulary</u>			
Students will learn key terms and phrases used for each topic studied in class.			
<u>Culture</u>			
Students will be introduced to the cultural aspects linked to each topic studied in class.			
Classroom methodology is a combination of group work, whole class lecturing and will include the use of technology to support and enhance learning.
