Aims/Objectives/Rationale:			
<p>This module is designed to further develop the German language skills of students who have completed LG-2404. German will be the primary medium of instruction. The module will provide ample practice to students to perform most of the language functions needed for areas related to communication in academic and professional situations. All four skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking will be integrated in the module.</p>			
Module Content:			
<p>In this module, students will engage in more complex conversations in German on a range of more specialized topics. They will be expected to initiate, maintain and also lead longer conversations of greater depth and intensity.</p> <p>Students will also be taught to use language appropriately depending on the social context; to understand, express and comment orally and in writing on abstract concepts such as opinions, emotions and impressions; and to discuss various issues pertaining to cultural and social subjects.</p> <p>Classroom methodology is a combination of group work and whole class explanation and will include extensive use of technology and media to support and enhance learning.</p>
