Aims/Objectives/Rationale:			
<p>This module is designed to consolidate the Japanese skills of students who have completed LJ-1403 Japanese I. The class will primarily be taught in Japanese although some English explanations will be given when necessary.</p> <p>At the end of the module, students will be able to engage in routine conversations in Japanese in situations that include the request for and provision of personal information, ordinary transactions and basic telephone skills, read and write simple texts in Japanese Hiragana and Katakana script.</p>			
Module Content :			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Practice in speaking and listening in contexts such as: traveling and holidays, shopping, accommodation, other specialized contest such as seeing doctors, dealing in banks, and explaining past events. ● Pronunciation practice ● Practice in reading simple texts in Japanese ● Practice in writing Japanese script including a review of Hiragana and the acquisition of Katakana ● The teaching of related Japanese grammatical and lexical items for the contexts mentioned and relevant areas of Japanese culture and customs will be integrated into the module.
