<b>Aims :</b>	This module develops further the skills taught in LM-1403 with the aim of increasing fluency and the ability to write Chinese characters.		
<b>Module Content :</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All the themes in this module have an added dimension—cultural knowledge related to that topic.</li> <li>• The emphasis at this level is the writing of extended sentence structures leading to simple continuous texts. The writing of Chinese characters is also introduced for the first time.</li> <li>• The dialogues and conversations are for special contexts which include: hospitals, accommodation, shopping, festivals, and making friends.</li> <li>• Speech patterns are more creatively used and combined and applied across topics for more effective communication.</li> <li>• Students are also taught to listen for detailed information and learn to extrapolate other cultural aspects based on the context.</li> </ul>
