## Aims/Objectives/Rationale:

The module is designed to further develop the Japanese language skills of students who have completed LJ-1403 and LJ-2403. Japanese will be the primary means of instruction although English explanations may still be given for advanced expressions and concepts.

Students will be given practice to enable them to engage in complex conversations in Japanese in greater depth and intensity and compose different genres of texts.

## **Module Content:**

In this module students will engage in a range of more specialised topics in personal/informal, and professional/formal contexts. They will be encouraged to initiate, maintain and lead longer conversations. Students will also be taught to read authentic texts in Japanese script involving more advanced combinations of Hiragana, Katakana and basic Kanji characters. Besides that, these students will write texts in Japanese script and reproduce the combinatory formation and graphical production of Hiragana, Katakana and basic Kanji characters.

The teaching of Japanese grammatical and lexical items and relevant areas of Japanese culture and customs will be integrated into the teaching of the above skills.
