## Aims/Objectives/Rationale:

This module builds on their skills in LK-1403 by increasing their oral fluency and ability to write in Hangeul. There will be more emphasis and focus on the written and listening skills although all the four skills (reading, writing, listening and spoken) will be covered in this module.

## **Module Content:**

LK-2403 has four main strands and this will be dealt with in the following manner in class.

- (a) Getting more grammatical practice to increase accuracy tense markers, past and future and models.
- (b) Developing greater oral fluency through the construction of compound sentences and promoting the creative construction and combination of sentences to enable longer stretches of discourse.
- (c) Actively listening to longer dialogues and contextualized conversations for special purposes. These listening texts are longer and more demanding of students discriminatory skills in the language.
- (d) Encouraging more accuracy as well as fluency in writing. Students will be introduced to relevant vocabulary, and taught to create new combinations of phrases and sentences from the vocabulary taught.
